INTRODUCTION

ALL THINGS NEW: A DISCIPLESHIP MINISTRY FOR HEALING is a Bible Study and Discipleship Ministry for people who are conflicted about their own lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, or queer (LGBTQ) identity. It is designed to be facilitated by lay leaders and assisted by volunteer prayer/Accountability Partners. The purpose of the All Things New Ministry is to aid in the spiritual healing and growth of people who are in bondage to false identities, and enable them understand their true identity as a child of God. Participants in the ministry will experience true love and healing from the Lover of their soul, Jesus Christ.

Each lesson contains five days of homework to be completed by the ministry participants prior to meeting as a group to discuss the lesson and complete the in-class exercises. Another very important aspect of this ministry is the weekly memory Scripture that relates to the lesson for the weekly memory.

If you are completing this Participant's Workbook on you and not using it as a part of a facilitated weekly Bible study, you will need to purchase the companion Facilitator's Guide in order to have access to all of the material you need to get the most out of this Brands Study. This is especially relevant to the in-class exercises presented in this Participant's Workbook and use the Facilitator's Guide, or someone who is facilitating this Bible Study that is using that Facilitator. Guransome of the exercises may not make sense.

ACCOUNTABILITY PARTNERS

We grow spiritually as Christians by share of our lives with other Christians. One important aspect of this Ministry is for you to have a trust defense of Accountability Partner to share your journey with as you work through the homework and make a weekly lessons. There will be times as you work through this material that you may feel lesson up or giving in to temptations that have been gripping you for years. Having an Accountability Partner who you can reach out to in times of temptation, or when you need a friend who understands what you are going through, can really help you to stay the course and experience victory over your struggles.

You may be assigned an Accountability Partner by the Ministry Facilitator(s) to work with you, or if you are completing this Participant's Workbook on your own, please find someone who you trust; who you feel comfortable talking to; and who you can contact when you have questions or are struggling to complete an assignment. That person's role is to encourage you and to pray for you. Stay in regular contact with your Accountability Partner – sharing the homework assignments with them and letting them know how you are feeling as you work through this material.
